

Declaration of accessibility

for the entities referred to in Article 3, paragraph 1-bis of Law 9 January 2004, no. 4

FONDAZIONE MILAN ETS is committed to making its website accessible, in accordance with Law No. 4 of January 9, 2004.

This accessibility statement applies to the website *Fondazione Milan* (<https://www.fondazionemilan.org/>).

Compliance Status

Partially compliant.

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard due to the cases of non-compliance listed below.

Non-accessible Content

The following content is not accessible due to non-compliance with Law No. 4 of January 9, 2004.

The following non-accessible content may cause difficulties for people with disabilities:

- Some functionalities are not accessible via keyboard navigation (9.2.1.1 - 9.2.1.2);
- In some pages, the purpose of certain links is occasionally missing (9.2.4.4);
- Navigation with assistive technologies may be limited due to components that are not detectable or usable, or due to missing start/end tags (9.4.1.1 – 9.4.1.2);
- For some elements, the focus indicator is not visible in the user interface when using a keyboard (9.2.4.7);
- Some elements do not receive focus in an order that preserves meaning and operability (9.2.4.3);
- In some cases, color is used as the only visual means of conveying information or distinguishing a visual element (9.1.4.1);
- The contrast between text color and background is not always sufficient (9.1.4.3 - 9.1.4.11);
- On some pages, when zooming to 200%, the content does not adapt correctly (9.1.4.4 – 9.1.4.10);
- For some content, the purpose of each input field requesting user information cannot be determined programmatically (9.1.3.5);
- For some content implemented using markup languages that support text styling properties, there may be a loss of content or functionality (9.1.4.12);

- On some content, mouse hover or keyboard focus does not make hidden content visible (9.1.4.13);
- No mechanism is available on the website to skip blocks of content repeated across multiple web pages (9.2.4.1);
- Navigation mechanisms repeated across multiple web pages within a set of pages do not always appear in the same relative order each time they are repeated (9.3.2.2);
- Information, structure, and relationships conveyed through presentation are not programmatically determined or available via text (9.1.3.1);
- Functionalities cannot be activated by device or user motion (9.2.5.4).
- Some interactive elements (such as buttons, links, or icons) do not have a minimum clickable size, or sufficient space around them if they are smaller (2.5.8)

FONDAZIONE MILAN ETS is planning a series of corrective actions to improve accessibility.
